

Additional Information for Nominations from the Floor

As per C&MA Polity and the instructions for a Special Election of District Superintendent as outlined by the National Office of the C&MA please be aware of the following protocol for nominations from the floor.

Beginning February 15, 2026, there is a 30 day period open for officially licensed workers to make nominations from the floor to be received by the Nominating Committee. Any names that you, as an officially licensed worker, wish to place in nomination from the floor must be received at dsnominations@metrocoma.org by **March 17, 2026**.

There are two important items to be aware of before making your nomination:

- 1) Please confirm the person you wish to nominate qualifies for the position by reviewing the District Superintendent Job Description:

- 2) Please do not contact the person you wish to nominate.

After the Nominating Committee has received your email, the name must be approved by the Vice President for Church Ministries. You, as a licensed official worker, will then be contacted to confirm whether or not you may approach the potential nominee.

Once asked if a potential floor nominee will let their name stand, that potential floor nominee must email dsnominations@metrocoma.org by **March 17, 2026** to confirm they are willing to let their name stand for nomination from the floor.

After the 30 day window for floor nominations has closed, any and all floor nominations will be vetted by the Nominating Committee prior to a Special Election during which floor nominations may be made by the licensed worker who originally made the nomination via email.

The name is placed into nomination from the floor only if they are nominated from the floor as part of the Special Election.
